Verification or fact checking?

Verification = the pre-publication checking of facts ('journalistic routine')

Fact checking =

- 1. Attached to newsrooms
- 2. Fact checking organizations/individuals (Politifact)




Het aantal asielzoekers in Nederland dat terug wil naar het land van herkomst neemt toe. Volgens de Internationale Organisatie voor Migratie (IOM) bevinden zich onder de huidige hoge instroom van asielzoekers relatief veel migranten die om verschillende redenen de uitkomst van hun asielaanvraag niet afwachten. De IOM begeleidt hen bij hun terugkeer.

Aan het Kamerlid Joël Voordewind (ChristenUnie) heeft de IOM laten weten dat het in december om 300 mensen ging, voornamelijk mannen uit Irak. "Het zijn mannen die hun gezin hebben moeten achterlaten", zei hij in het NOS-programma Met Het Oog Op Morgen. "Die vrouw en kinderen houden het wel een paar maanden uit, als het gaat om het betalen van de huur. Maar op een gegeven moment worden zij ook wanhopig en vragen ze hun mannen om terug te keren."

Voordewind noemt het een heel opmerkelijke trend. "Dit heb ik in al die jaren dat ik asiel doe nog niet meegemaakt." In december vorig jaar werden er ongeveer 4000 asielaanvragen in Nederland ingediend.





The context of facts

The news was framed in the context of the current refugee crisis and debate - at that time mainly focused on Syrians.

As an explanation for the remarkable data, people pointed towards the recent policy changes that made it harder for refugees to get asylum, prompting them to prefer returning home instead of waiting in uncertainty.

But whoever looked into the data, saw that of all returning refugees, there were only six of them from Syria...





Fact checking is not simply finding truth, it's much more complicated.

It involves asking a lot of questions, understanding the (political, cultural) context, seeing through framing.

All facts might be correct, but the story told a lie.


